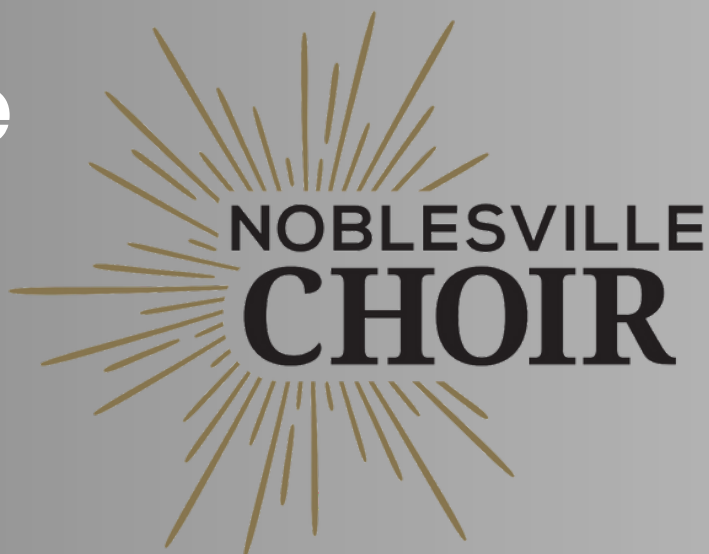

SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Soprano

At the \$500 level, you will receive 8 reserved seats* and recognition in the choir program for each concert

Alto

At the \$350 level, you will receive 6 reserved seats* and recognition in the choir program for each concert.

Tenor

At the \$200 level, you will receive 4 reserved seats* and recognition in the choir program for each concert.

Bass

At the \$150 level, you will receive 2 reserved seats* and recognition in the choir program for each concert.

Patron

You may also choose a custom level of sponsorship. You will receive recognition in the choir program at each concert.

*Reserved seats are for free all concerts. For paid concerts, you will receive the link one day prior to the public to have the first opportunity to purchase the seats you would like. Musical is not included.
