DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Noblesville High School – 18111 Cumberland Rd, Noblesville, IN 46060

From North of Noblesville: Take I-69 South to State Rte. 38 W/W State Rd 38 in Pendleton. Take exit 219 from I-69 South and continue onto State Rte. 38 W/W State Rd 38 toward Noblesville. Continue to IN-32 W/State Rte. 38 W and turn left onto IN-32/State Rte. 38 W. Continue on IN-32/State Rte. 38W past IN -37 and turn right onto Cumberland Road. Continue past Noblesville High School to E 186th/Field Drive and take the 3rd exit of the roundabout onto Field Drive. Noblesville High School will be on your left.

From South of Noblesville: Take I-65 North. Merge onto I-465 East via exit 106B toward I-74/US-52. Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 40 for Shadeland Ave. Continue on Shadeland Avenue and use the 2nd from the right lane to take the ramp onto I-69 N/IN-37 N toward Ft. Wayne. Continue on I-69 North and take exit 205 for IN-37 North. Continue to E 186th/Field Drive and turn left. Go through the roundabout and Noblesville High School will be on your left.

SPECTATOR PARKING

Spectator parking will be in the lots on the east and south sides of Noblesville High School adjacent to the building. There are three entrances to the parking area, two off of Cumberland Road and one off of Monument Street. There will be signs indicating parking entrances.

ADMISSION

Wristbands will be sold for full-day general admission for \$20 inside the main entrance at Gate #1. Guests two and younger may sit on an adult's lap free of charge.

FOOD

The Indiana Show Choir Championships is a fund raiser for the Noblesville High School Choirs. Please refrain from bringing outside food and/or drink into NHS.

Concessions and vendors will be available throughout the day, beginning with our cafeteria at 7:00 am, and will be open all day for breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snacks. Our cafeteria has more than adequate space, which will ensure a fast and pleasant dining experience while you are here.

FAMILY SPACE

A new Family Space has been created this year for our younger guests. Located in Vendor Village, this space will provide activities as well as a quieter place for families to relax.

RECORDING & PHOTOGRAPHY

Noblesville High School Choirs has contracted Michael Camp Photography to provide professional photography for the event. Due to this arrangement, there will be no video, photographic, or audio recording equipment allowed in the venue. In addition, no cameras of any kind are allowed backstage.

Audience members are prohibited from making their own recordings of the performances. The performances are being filmed and live streamed by the NHS Student Broadcast Team. The video will reside on YouTube and be accessible to view live and after the event has ended as a YouTube video.

RESERVED SEATING

To encourage support for the performing choir, the first five rows will be reserved for fans of the performing choir. After your group is finished performing, please vacate these five rows to make room for fans of the following choir.



PROGRAMS

Programs will be available for \$5 each at the ticket entrance. Schedules of the day's events will be included in the program.

SHOUT OUTS/PEOPLES CHOICE/T-SHIRTS

Shoutouts will be on sale for \$1 per card. Instead of reading shoutouts from the stage, shoutouts will be posted onto your choir's poster in the hall. In addition, a limited number of commemorative event t-shirts will be available at the Shoutout table.

LOST AND FOUND

The Lost and Found is located at the Competition Headquarters (Main Office). In addition, Lost and Found drop bags will be located around the school. ISCC volunteers will pick up items throughout the day and bring them to Lost and Found.

FIRST AID

A First Aid station will be available throughout the day for anyone needing immediate attention. If any services are needed, help can be readily obtained from any contest official. The First Aid station will be located in Room 3006 directly behind the Auditorium.

COMPETITION HEADQUARTERS

Competition Headquarters will be located in the Main Office at Gate #1. The Headquarters will be staffed throughout the day.

JUDGES

A panel of 5 judges will evaluate each of the show choirs. All the judges will be judging "the whole sheet" as they are experts in the field and understand how to evaluate vocals, choreography, instrumentals, and overall show production. Each judge's scores will be converted to a ranking within the divisions as well as the overall competition.

SCORING

There are 3 judges adjudicating vocals and 2 judges adjudicating choreography. The placements will be based on the judge's scoring of their areas as well as their impressions of show design/effect. The band/instrumental ensemble will be evaluated for its contribution but the score of the band will not directly affect overall placements. This results in a 60% Vocal/40% Choreography split to create placements. After scoring is completed, the scores are converted to placement "votes".

For instance, Judge A may have Group #1 in first place with a total score of 99 and Group #2 in 2nd place with a total score of 50 while Judge B has Group #1 in first place with a total score of 80 and Group #2 in second place with a total score of 75. With the ranking conversion, both judge's scores will have the same impact on the competition and not result in judge's using point differentials to sway the contest results. Ranking conversion will take place for the Overall Winner as well as the subcategories, Vocal, Visual, and Instrumental. So, it is possible that a judge's scores could have 1 group receiving first place in vocals, a different group receiving first place in Visuals and yet another group receiving first place in instrumentals. Their total score generates their vote for the winner of the division with 60% of the score coming from vocal and 40% coming from visual.

Depending on how many choirs are in each division, points are awarded for each judge's scores. For Small Mixed, there are 6 choirs. Therefore, a first-place vote receives 6 ranking points. A second-place vote receives 5 ranking points. and so on. After all scores are submitted and verified, the choir with the highest total ranked points would emerge as the Champion of that Division. Rankings within the subcategories will also generate awards for Best Vocals and Best Visual. In the event of a tie in ranking points, the choir with a higher ranking by the majority of the judges would be awarded the higher ranking. If a judge does tie two choirs in ranking overall or any subcategory, the choir with the higher vocal ranking would emerge as the winner of that tie. If the tie persists, the ranking and awards will be announced as a tie by decision of the judges.
